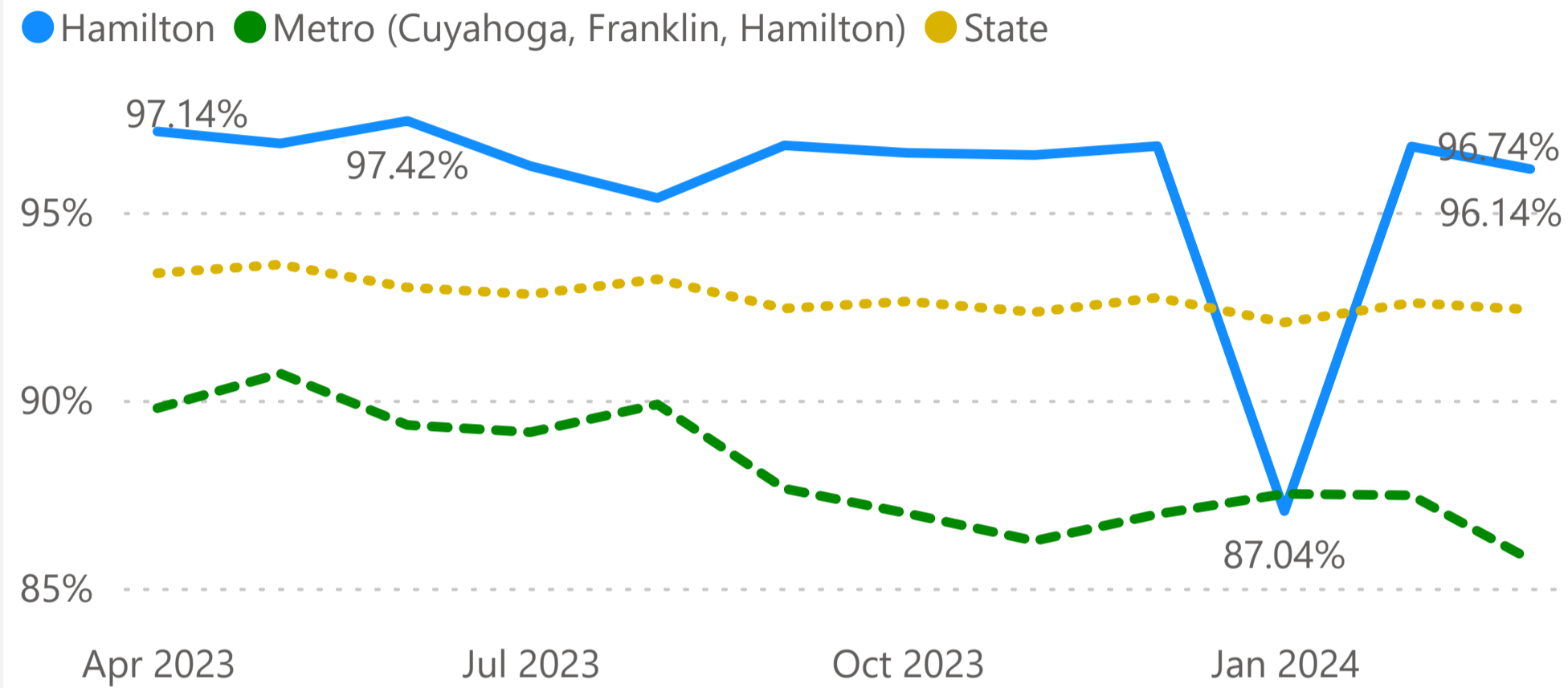


Food & Cash Assistance (Data ending 3/31/2024; Updated: 4/2024)

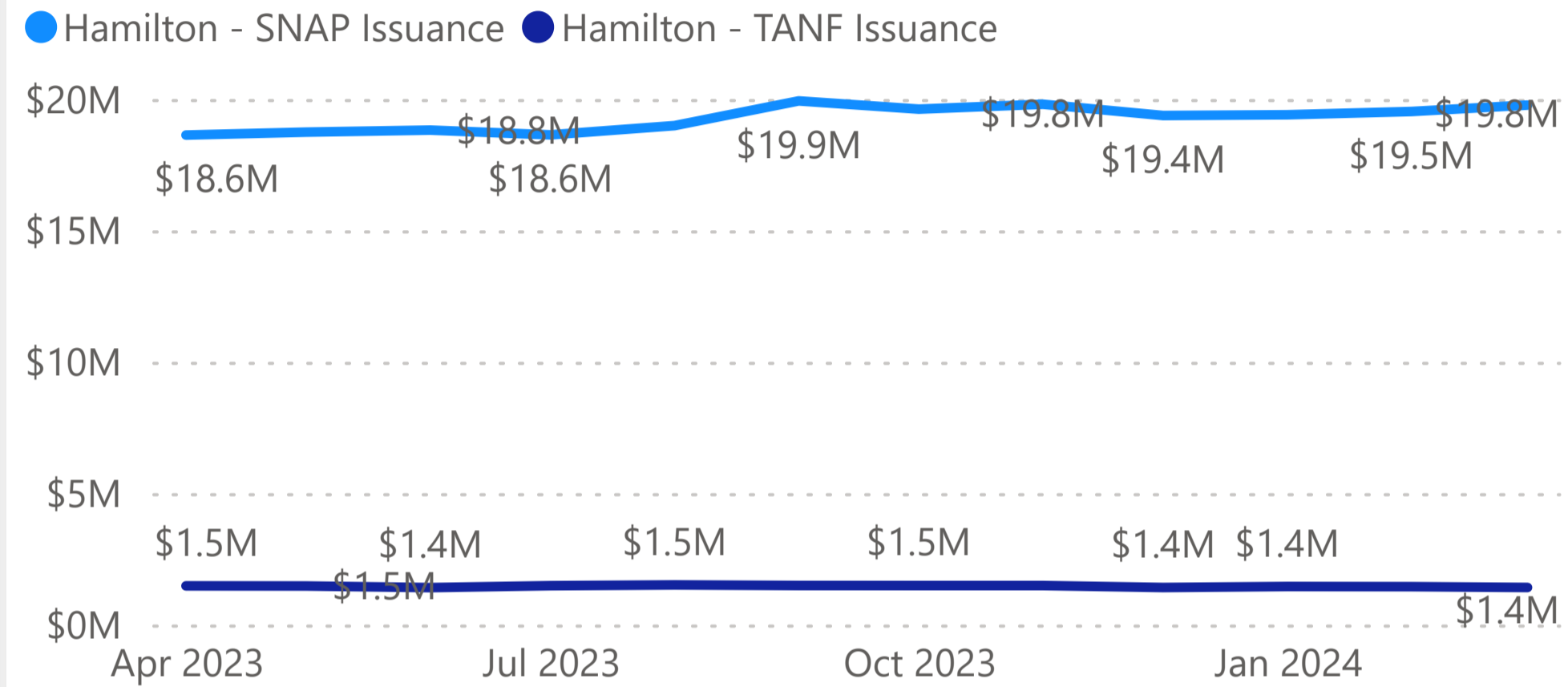

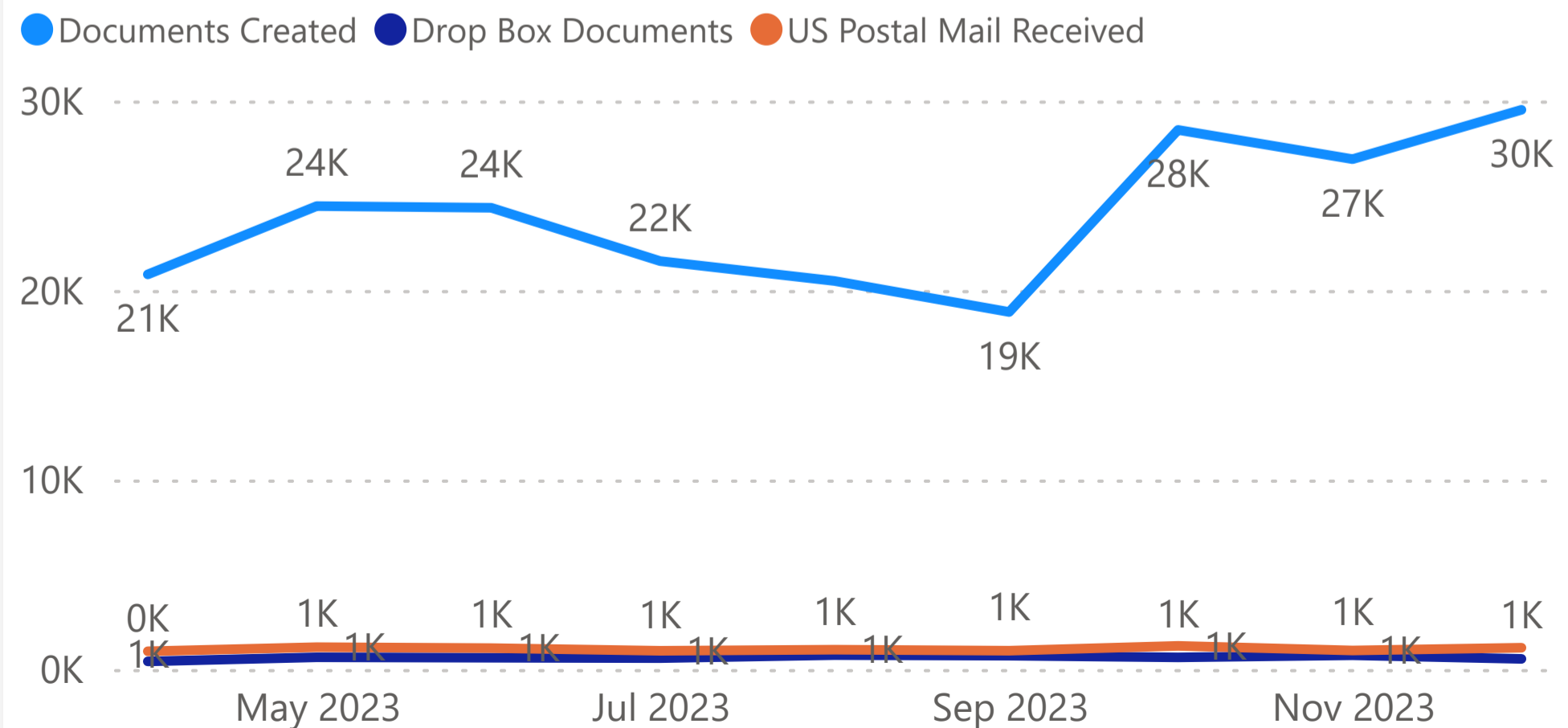

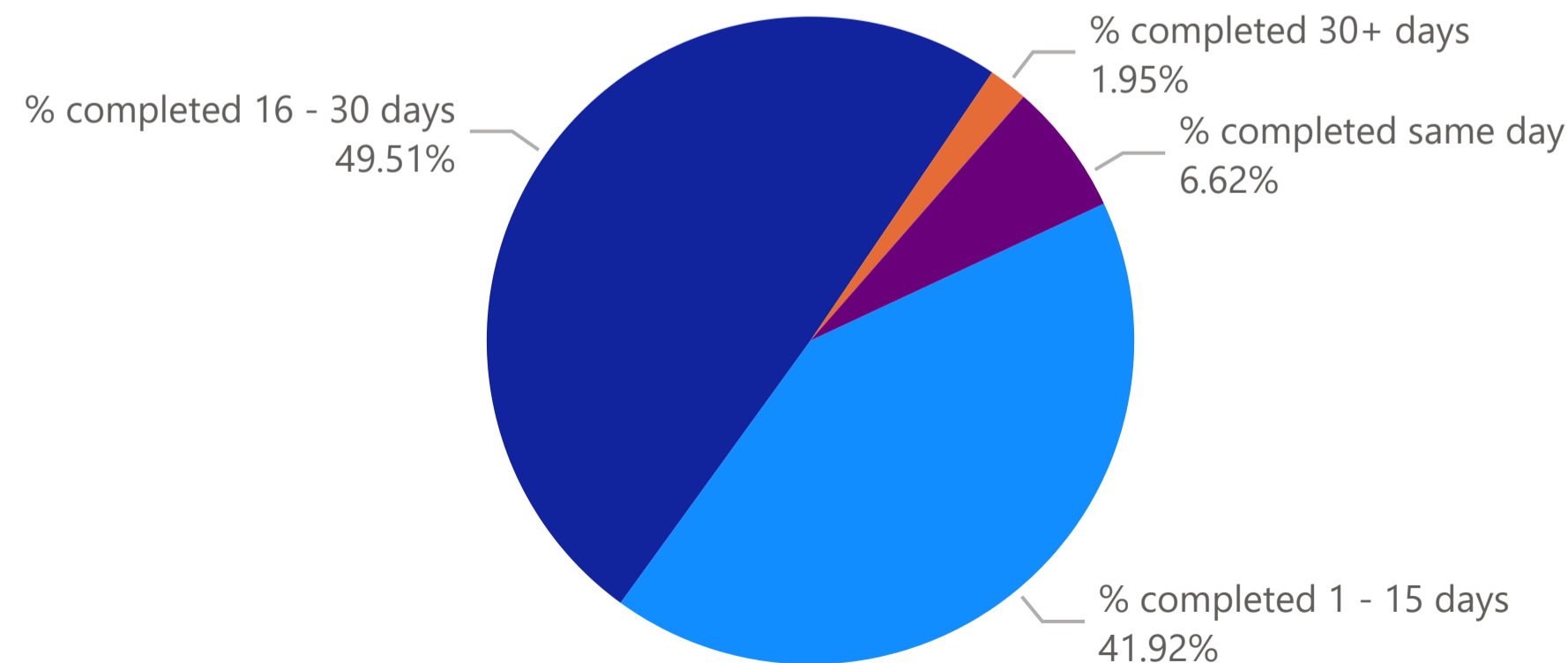

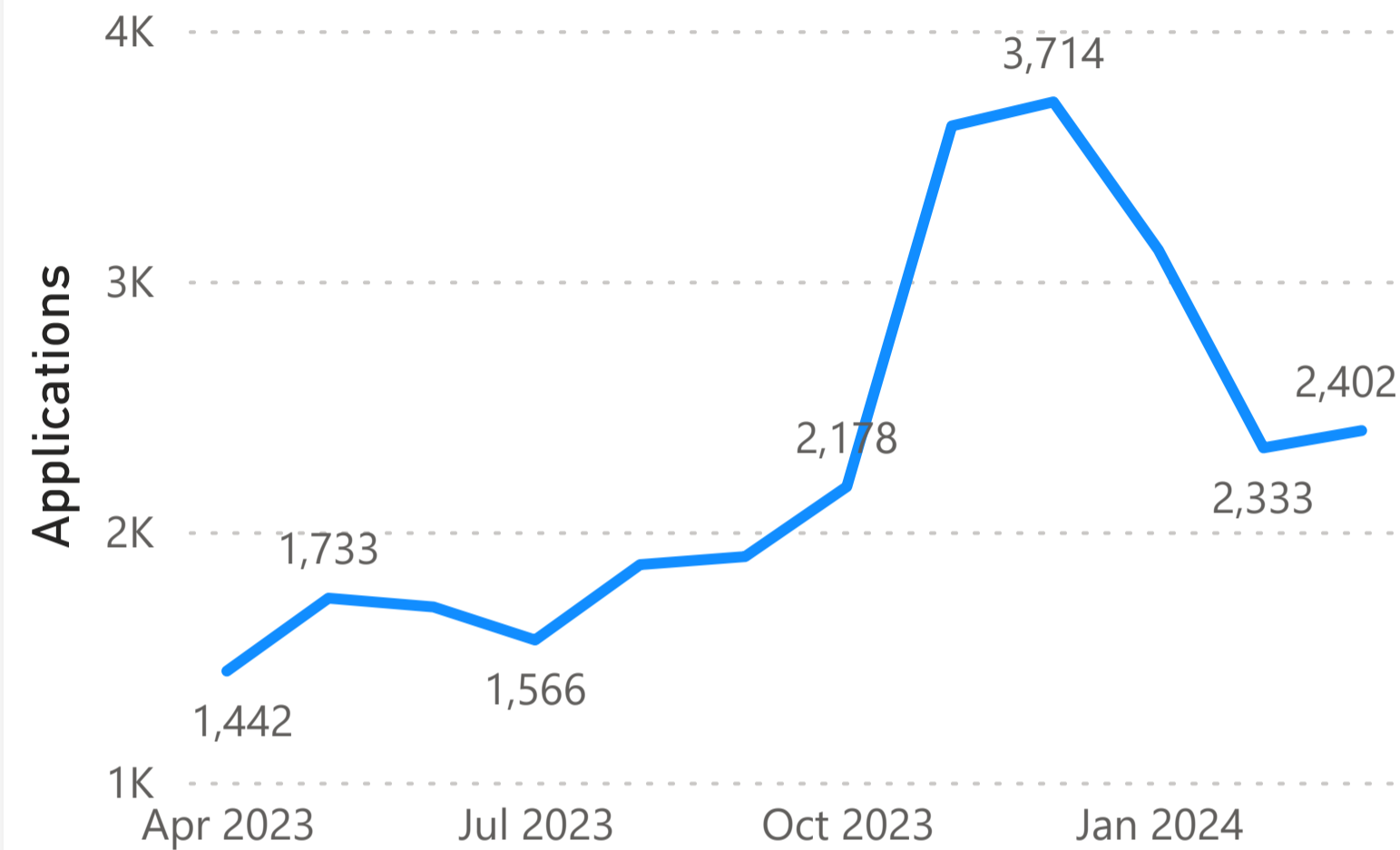
Medicaid (Data ending 3/31/2024; Updated: 4/2024)

Medicaid is vital to many Hamilton County families. Over 200,000 citizens have Medicaid, including approximately 19,000 seniors over 65 years old and 102,000 minor children. Medicaid renewals processing is current and often in under 30 days.

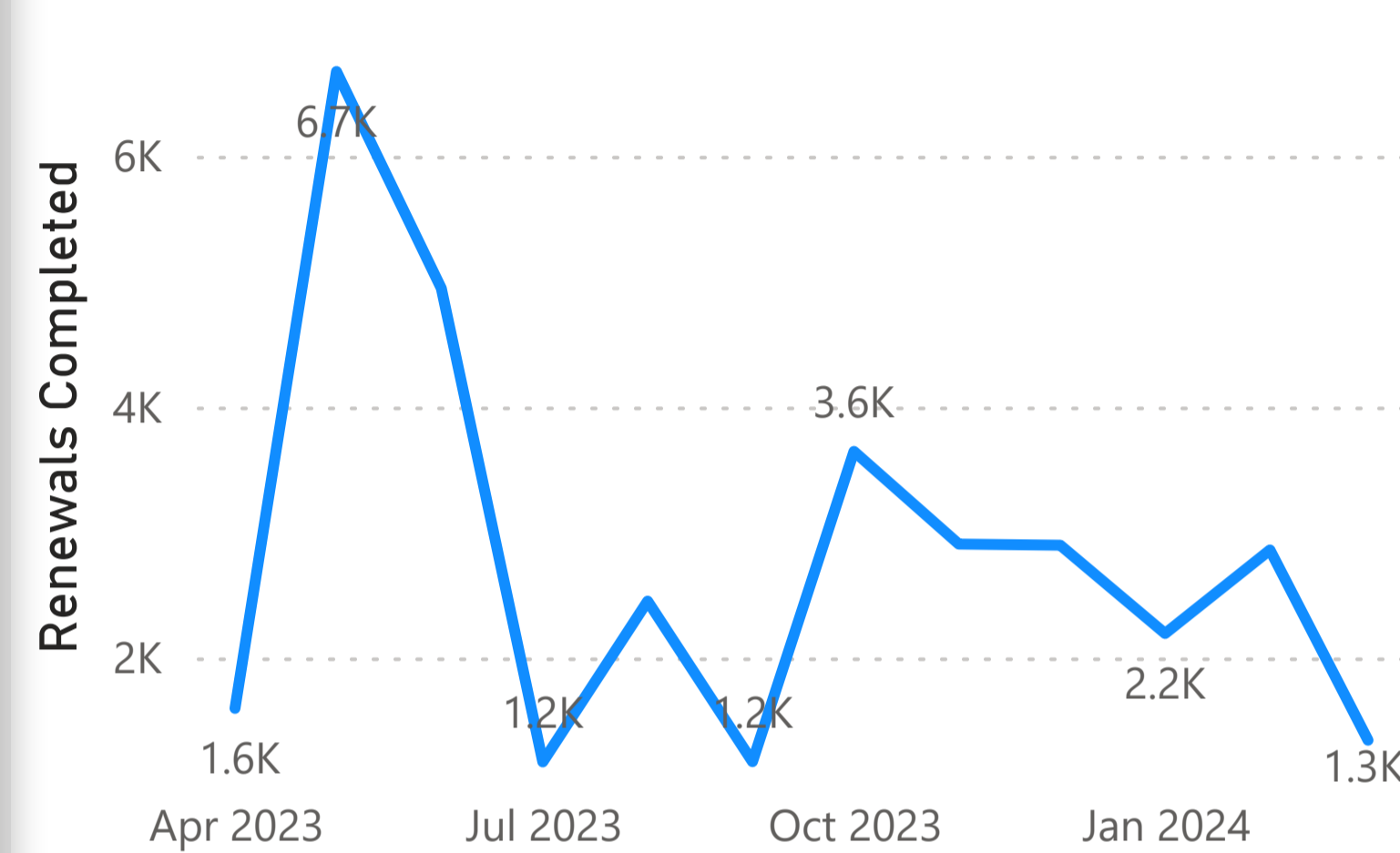


Due to implementation of the new Ohio Medicaid Enterprise System and changes to the Data Warehouse, there will be delay in updating Medicaid Payments data until further notice.

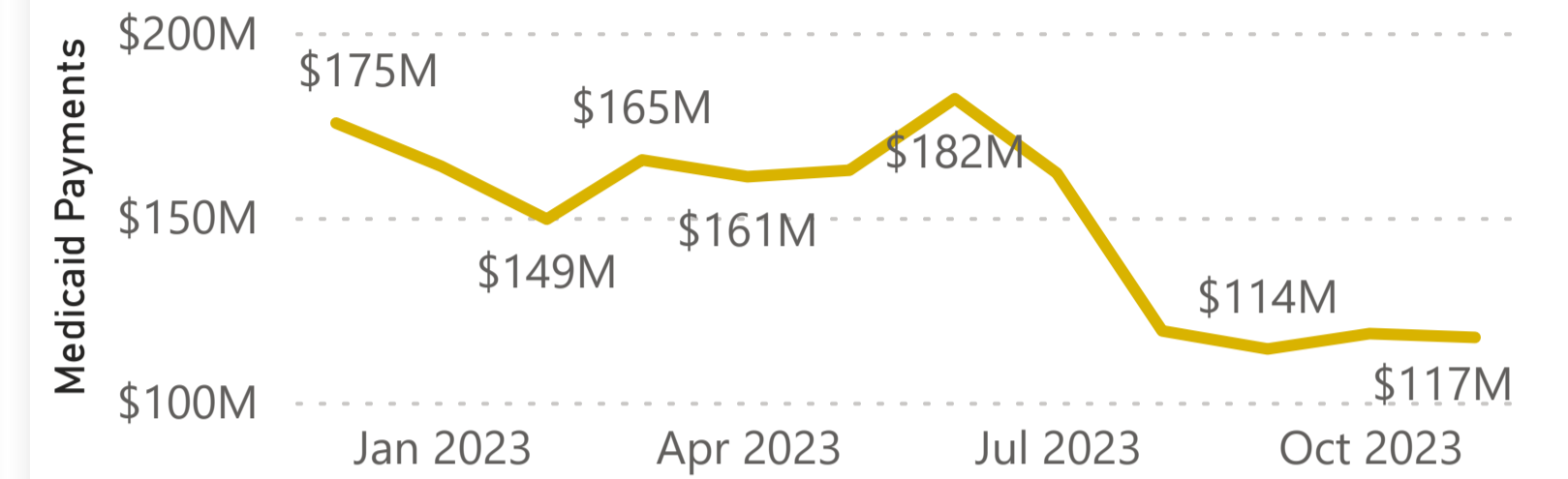
Medicaid Applications Received (Ending 1/31/2024)

Medicaid Recipients (Current Month)

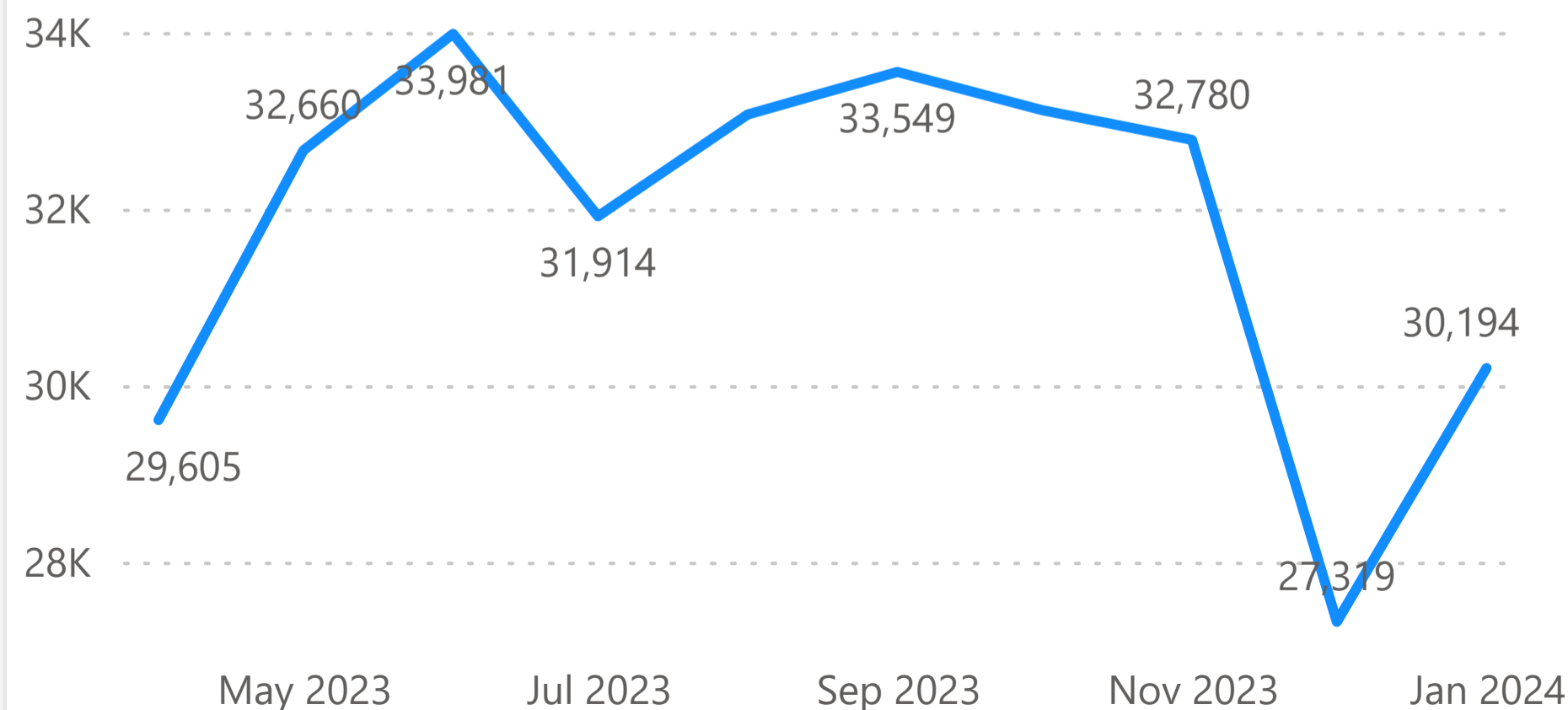

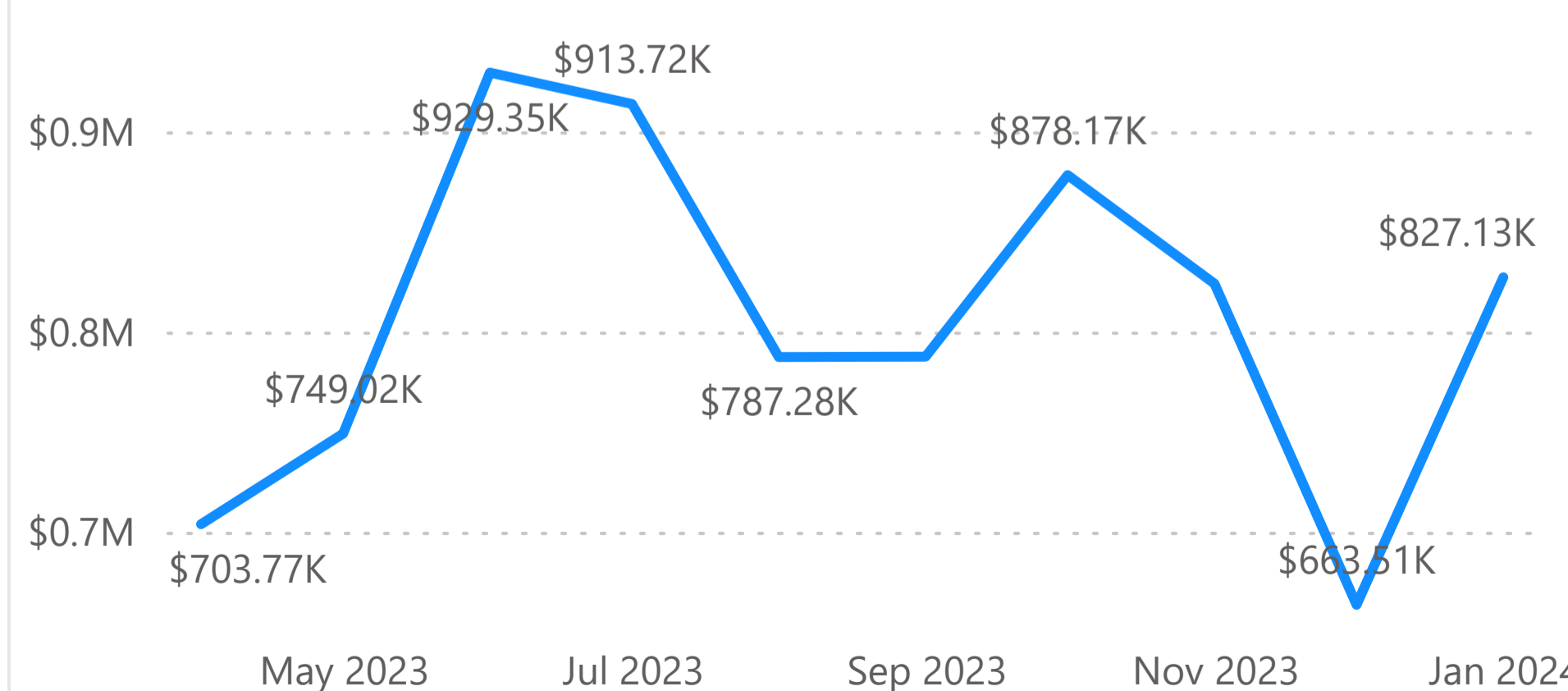

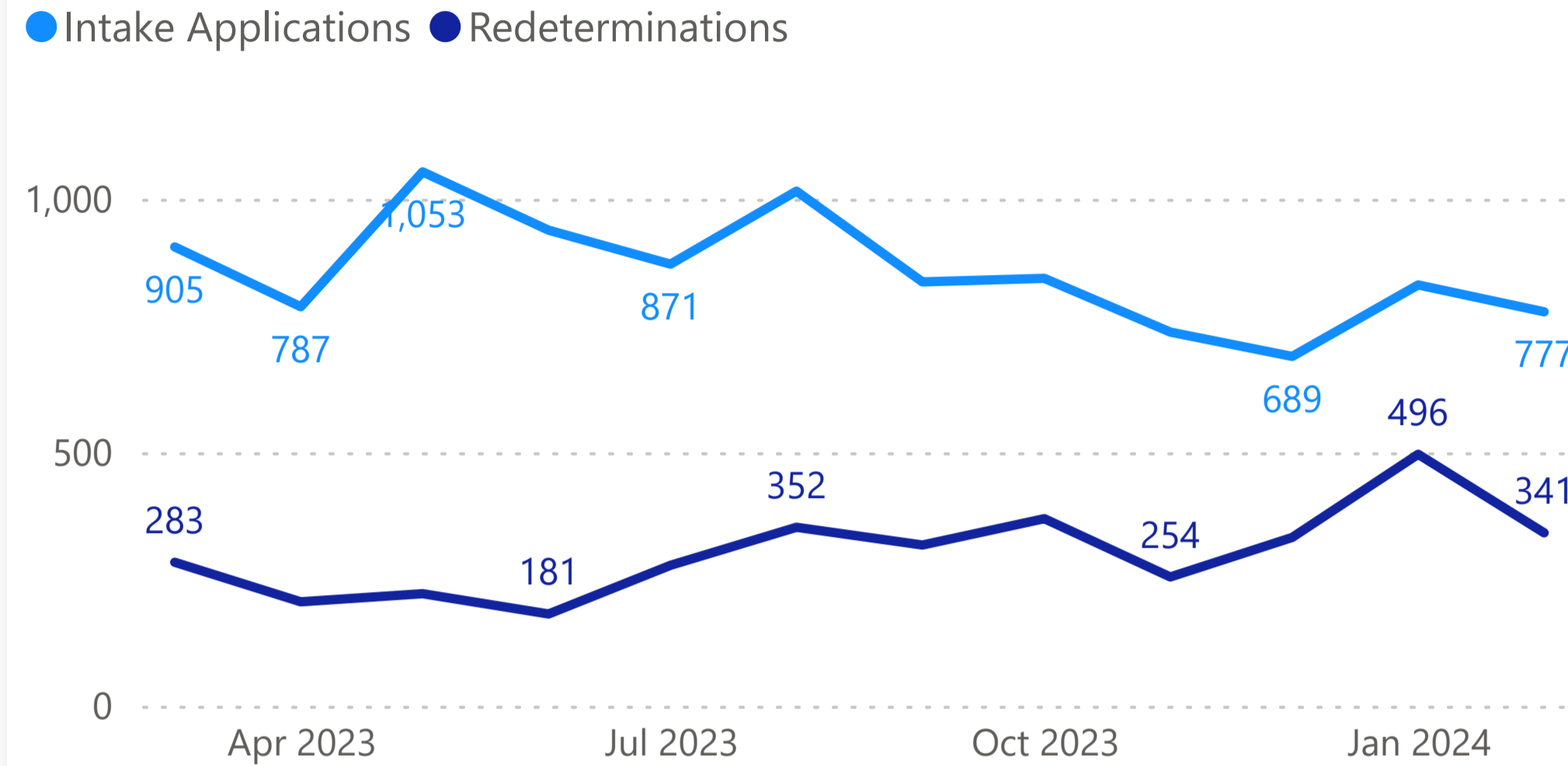

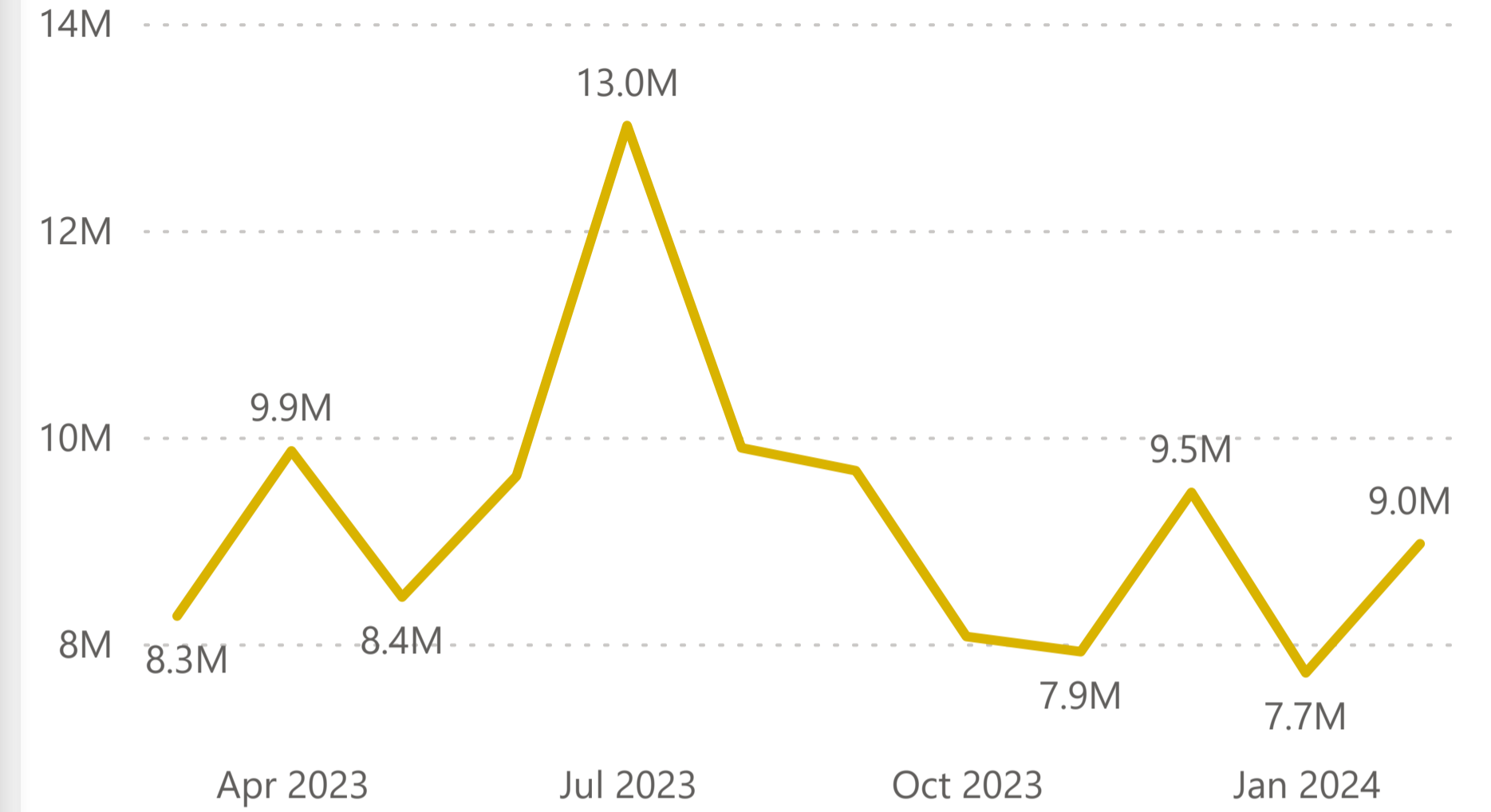

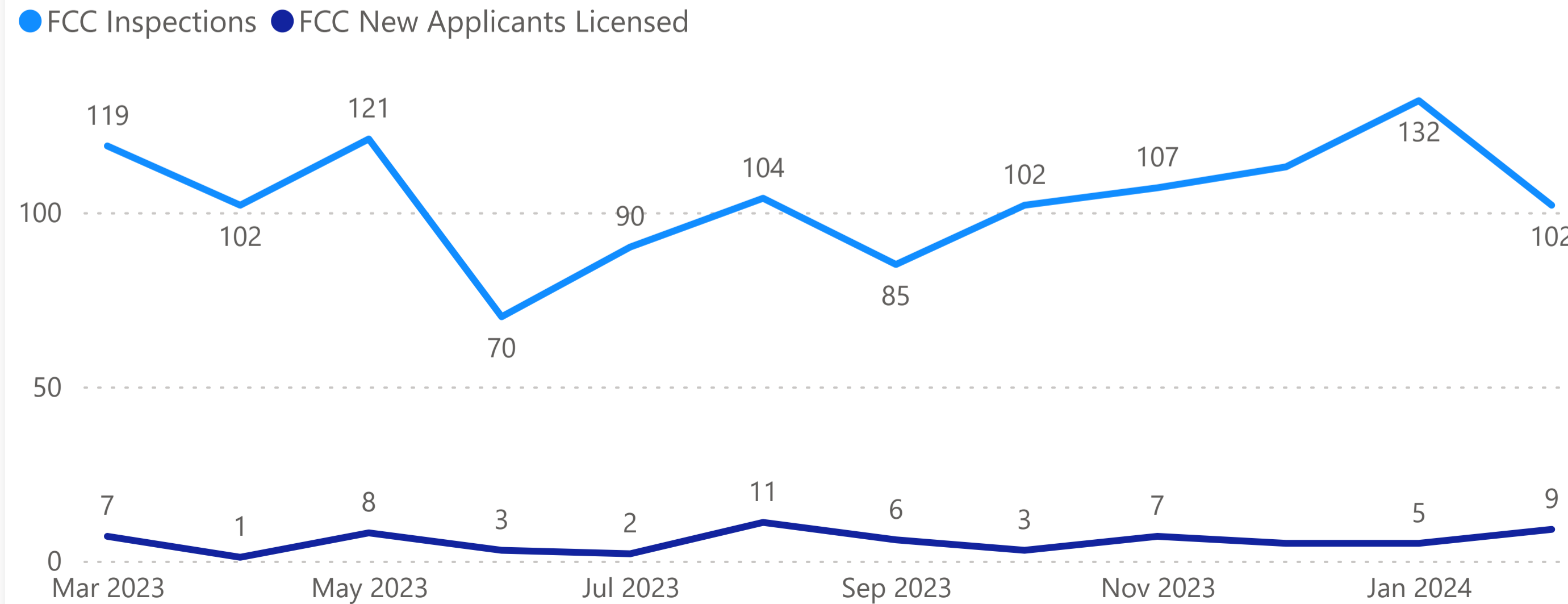
Child Care Applications Received (Ending 1/31/2024)



Publicly Funded Child Care



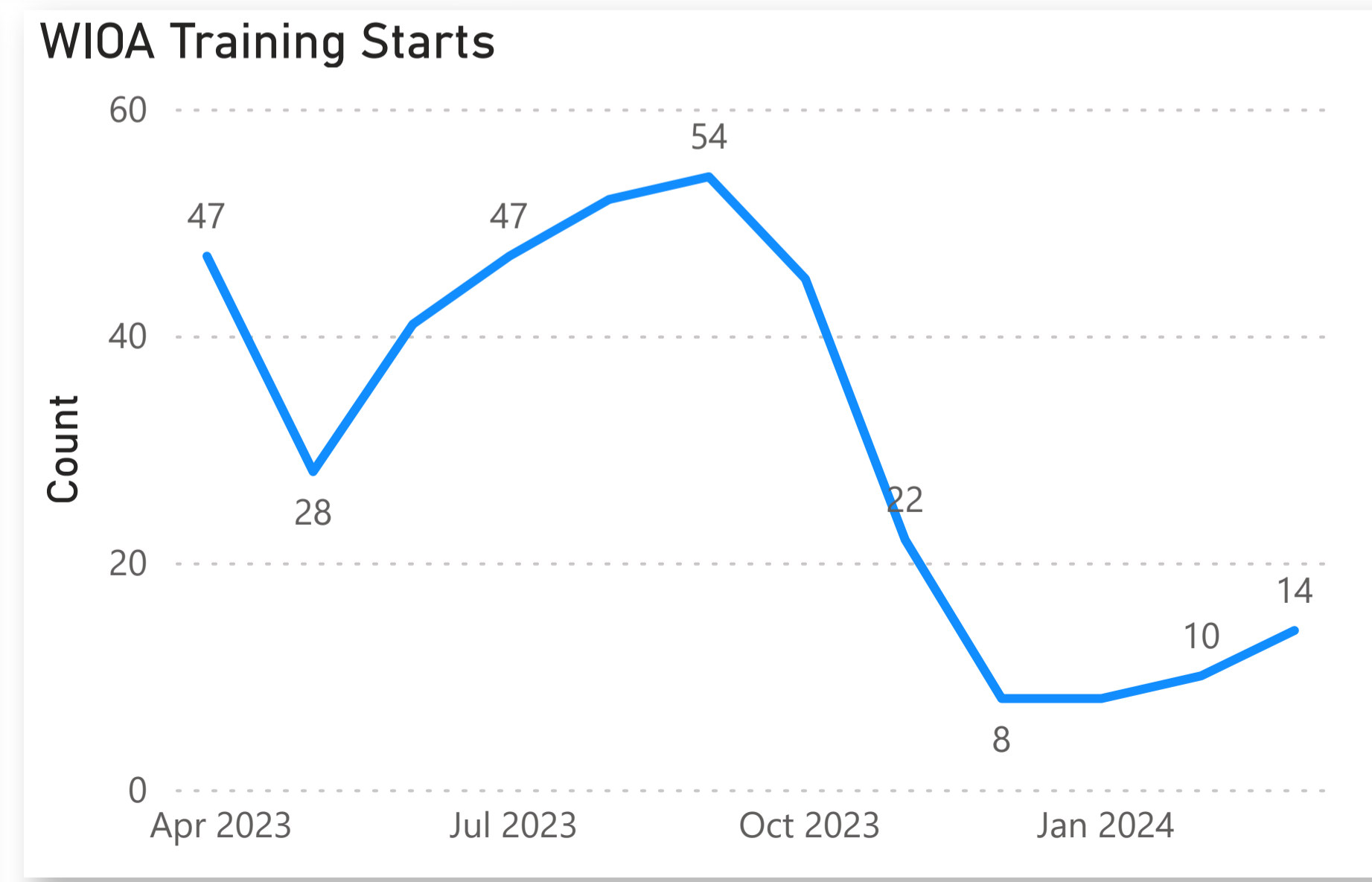
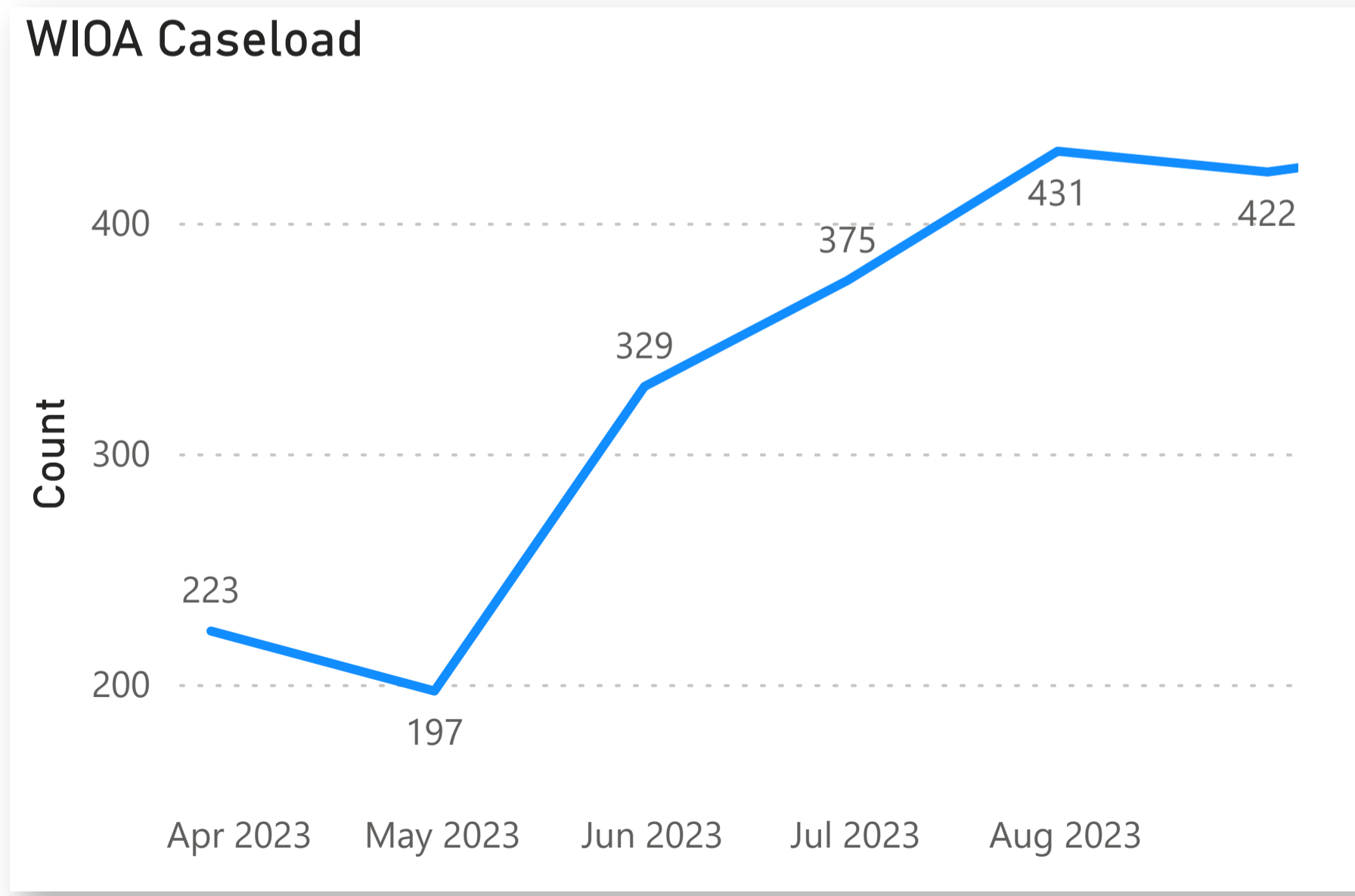
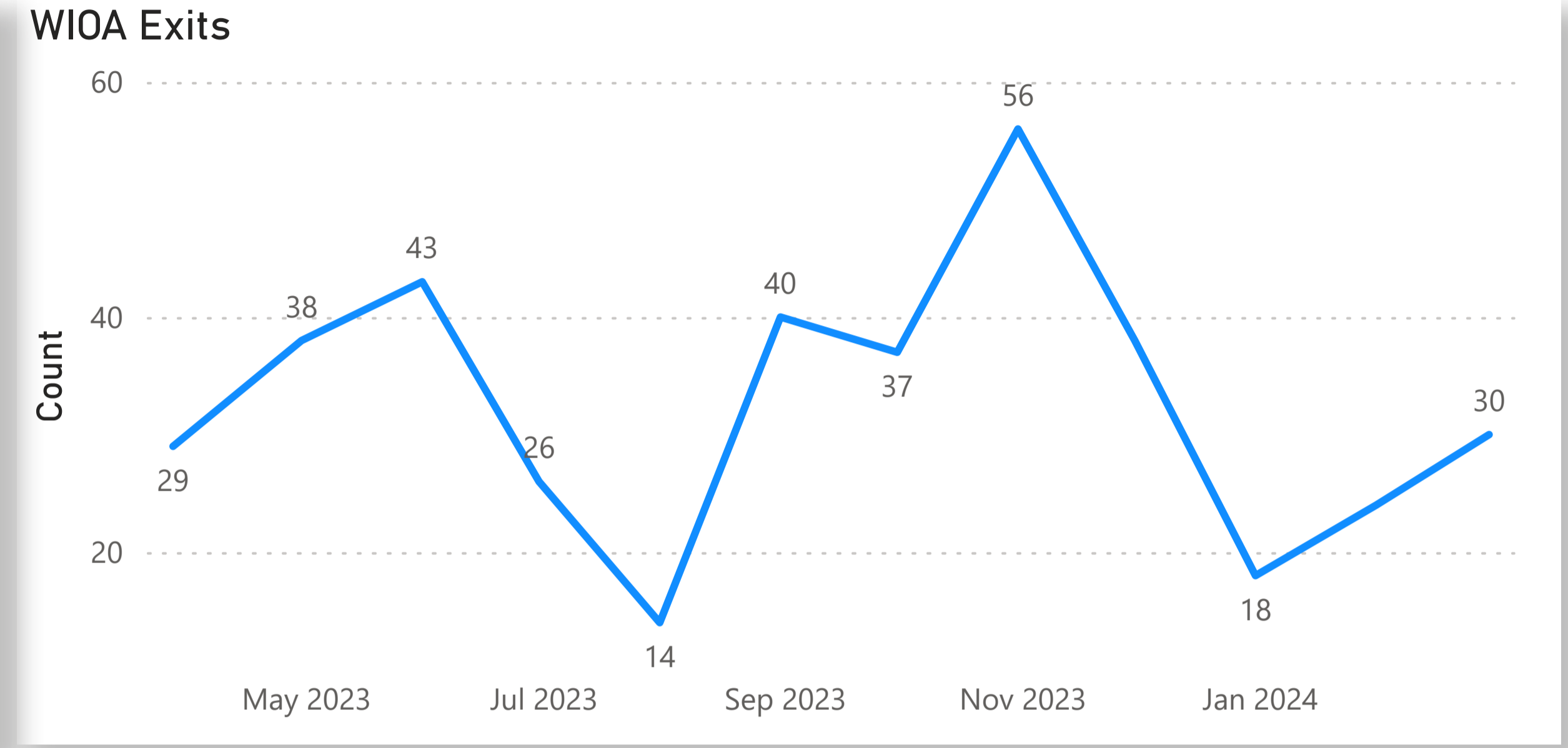
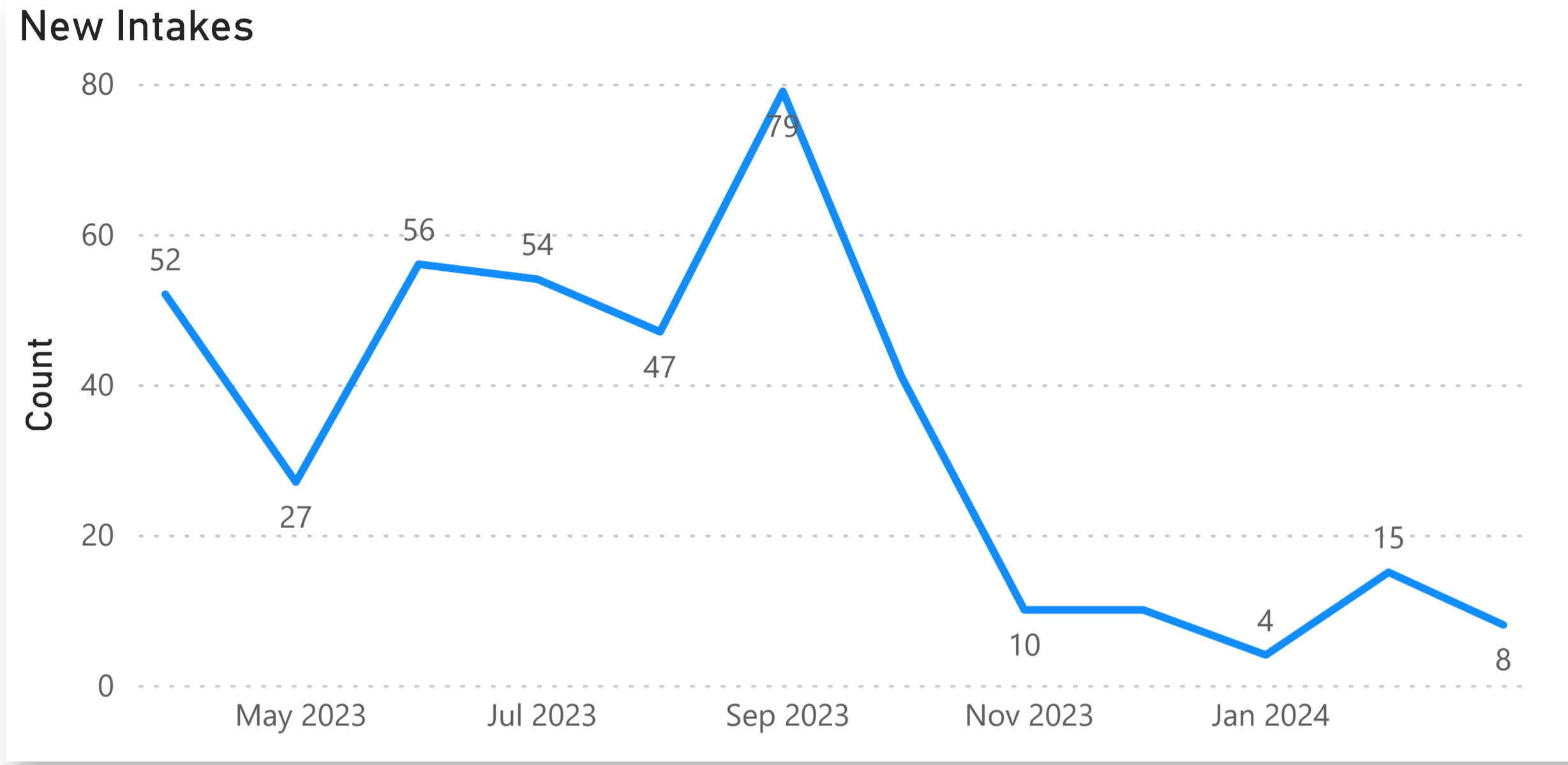
Family Child Care Home Licensing (Ending 1/31/24)

Child Care is vital to many Hamilton County families; allowing parents to maintain employment or schooling while receiving quality child care for their children.

Pandemic Impact - Closure of child cares during the pandemic impacted total investment. Extension of eligibility periods impacts the volume of redeterminations. Low redeterminations are expected to continue for several months.
