Request for Cash, Food, and Medical Assistance*	 Cash Assistance: Provides a monthly benefit to eligible low income families with minor children at home. Known as Ohio Works First (OWF). Families may receive assistance for up to 36 months. Food Assistance: A monthly benefit given to families to help buy food. Known as the Ohio Direction Card. Medicaid: State and federally-funded health care coverage for income-eligible parents and their children up to age 21, pregnant women, older adults, and people with disabilities. Medicaid also covers waiver programs of DDS (Developmental Disabilities Services – formerly MRDD), Ohio Home Care, Passport and Pace. Child Support

Child Support is money required by law to be paid by one parent to another parent to help cover the costs of raising their children. The HCJFS Child Support Division: establishes and enforces child support orders; establishes paternity; modifies child support orders; enforces spousal support; performs other customer services.

To make child support payments BY MONEYGRAM:

- You may now make cash payments at many retail locations throughout the State where MoneyGram payment services are offered, or online by credit card using the "Pay Bills" option at www.moneygram.com.
- Use state code 14674 when using MoneyGram services.
- There is a fee based on the transaction amount. Fee guidelines are available on www.moneygram.com.

Collections:

Employers and non-custodial parents can remit support payments to Ohio CSPC through direct debit of their checking or savings account using ExpertPay.com. There is no charge for payments sent to Ohio CSPC; however, users may pay a nominal fee for payments remitted to other states.

Non-custodial parents can remit their support payments using a MasterCard credit card on the <u>e-childsPay.com</u> website. **Note**: There is a fee charged by the processor to make a credit card payment & it takes up to 14 days.

Children's Services

Children's Services is the HCJFS division legally responsible for responding to reports of child abuse, neglect and dependency (241-KIDS); acting to protect child victims; and recruiting foster and adoptive parents.
