Questions asked during RFP Conference:

Q1. Regarding care manager/therapist: Can they bill CPST?

A. Yes.

Q2. Emergency referral placements will last 1-7 days. What is the rate?

A: Assessment specifications will be child-specific. An assessment may be as simple as reporting the daily needs of a child or JFS may request that a network complete a DAF on the child.

A 30 day notice of removal will not be required in these cases. It will be expected however that there will be a "no reject, no eject" rule for the child/youth referred to these homes. JFS is anticipating that the length of stay in these homes will be 1-7 days.

At this time, placement options must be licensed caregivers. Alternate caregivers for respite do not need to be licensed.

Q3. Regarding respite – please explain “must be authorized.”

A: Please read #11 on page 12. Respite Providers should be approved and planned for in advance of their needing to be used. A respite plan should be in place within 30 days of a child’s placement into the foster home.
