Objective	Measurement	Incentive/ Reporting
<p><b>1. Children are safe and experience no re-occurrence of abuse or neglect.</b></p>	<p>Upon completion of visitation services, 96% will have no recurrence of maltreatment when the child (ren) has been reunified.</p> <p>Safe= no substantiated or indicated reports of maltreatment within 6 months from the point reunification occurs for children who are in care following receipt of visitation services.</p> <p>Children must remain in the care of their parents during the six month period.</p> <p>Recurrence= a substantiated or indicated report of maltreatment within 6 months from the point of successful reunification. Any child who re-enters foster care during this time period will be considered as recurrence.</p> <p><b>Eligible population:</b> Any family who has received and been successfully discharged from services to reunification during the contract period.</p>	<p><b>Incentive:</b></p> <p>Provider will receive a \$5000 incentive for meeting this performance measure.</p> <p><b>Reporting:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Provider will submit a report at the end of the contract period with names of families who were served with the date of discharge from services.</li> <li>b. HCJFS will compare against internal recurrence and re-entry reports to determine if goal is met</li> </ul>
