Questions Received after RFP Conference

Q1. Under 1.2.2, letter S #2, it says "Provide progress reports indicating goals, services provided to meet goals, progress towards goals, and attendance as requested by HCJFS." Is the expected frequency of these progress reports monthly as indicated in Exhibit 1 "Parenting Education Service Description"?

A. Exhibit 1 will be edited via addendum. Frequency will be as requested by HCJFS.

Q2. What is the % of current population served that is Medicaid eligible?

A. We do not have this data readily available specifically for adults who have been referred to this service. A similar population is parents who are referred for a mental health assessment through FAIR. Most of these parents are Medicaid eligible. Also, any child in JFS custody and many who are active on children services cases are Medicaid eligible.



- **Q3.** How are less than 24 hour no-shows and cancellations handled currently, i.e. no service = no money?
 - A. Correct, we do not provide payment.
- **Q4.** What is the current program no-show rate?
 - **A.**We do not readily have this information available.
- **Q5.** For the Medicaid eligible population, what, if any, services do you see as being billable (assessment, CPST, etc.) as part of this program?
 - **A.** We are open to providers accessing Medicaid. The assessment required in this RFP in Section 1.2.2 (Q) is specifically geared toward the clients parenting ability. We are not certain this would qualify for Medicaid reimbursement. We do encourage providers to explore billing Medicaid for therapy services that meet the requirements of this RFP.
