Questions asked during RFP Conference:

- Q1. Can incentives be included as a part of wage package?
 - **A.** They can, if they are substantial, tied to tangible results, and timely.
- Q2. Can you limit number of youth served based on your proposal?
 - A. Yes.
- **Q3.** How will we know if youth are in CCMEP?
 - **A.** The selected vendor will coordinate with the HCJFS contract manager to set up screening tools to determine suitability including cross-referrals of City SYEP youth and exclusion of CCMEP youth.



- **Q4.** When will the online application go live?
 - **A.** We have not decided that yet. The timing will be determined based on a fuller communication and roll out plan, probably with early and preferential treatment of community partner referrals.
- **Q5.** Is there a percentage cap on the indirect costs based on the actual costs?
 - A. Yes, no more than 15%.
- **Q6.** Are WIOA CCMEP youth eligible?
 - **A.** No, CCMEP WIOA youth are not eligible for SYEP program
- **Q7.** Are electronic signatures sufficient for paychecks?
 - A. Yes.
- **Q8.** Is training a payable activity for youth?
 - A. Yes.
- **Q9.** Do all youth need to be paid \$12.00 per hour, or can it vary by age?
 - **A.** All youth can be paid up to \$12.00 per hour.
- **Q10.** For clarification, youth participating are not enrolled in CCMEP/participating in CCMEP to be eligible, but can be put in CCMEP after eligible?
 - **A.** That's a little complicated. WIOA/CCMEP youth can be enrolled under this contract. Youth included in a TANF CCMEP household can-not. Any summer youth participants can volunteer to participate in CCMEP upon completion of summer youth services.
- **Q11.** How many youth have typically been served each summer?
 - **A.** This varies widely each year based on available funding. Our hope is to serve between 300 and 400 youth in 2020.



- Q12. Is intent for agency to have youth connected with services until 9/30/20?
 - **A.** Not necessarily. Your service models may end services earlier, or stagger enrollments and exits for briefer periods. Just be clear about your timelines in your proposal.
- Q13. Do we include program checklist with original proposal and all 8 copies of proposal?
 - A. Yes.
- Q14. Is there an expectation of percentage of time spent in soft skills vs. career exploration?
 - A. No.
- Q15. Section 1.2 Scope of Service on page 5 of the RFP states: *HCJFS reserves the right* to negotiate with the selected Provider to deliver some or all services identified in the contract scope during either summer months, or over a longer span of months. Would this include additional funds or the expenditure of current funds?
 - **A.** If funds were unspent at the end of this contract or if additional funds became available, HCJFS and the contracted party may mutually agree to extend or expand services.
